Collaboration: Ensuring stakeholders' needs are met and diverse interests and values are represented through all phases of a project.

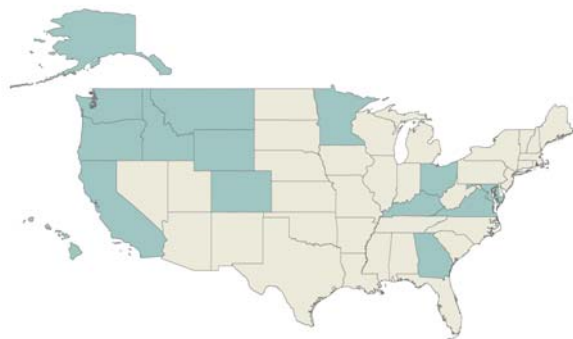
Empowerment: Connecting communities and clients with tools and resources that build capacity, foster learning, and increase mutual respect and equity.
